Mission of the Month Phoenix Rising Education Program (PREP)

PREP exists to educate both children and adults on internet safety with the goal of child



exploitation and human trafficking prevention. They hold community events in and around Spearfish to educate parents, grandparents, caregivers, and community members about keeping kids safe online. They partner with other organizations from across the state to provide up-to-date information on trends and tactics online predators are using in South Dakota and across the Nation.

Their outreach Coordinator works with schools to present age-appropriate education to students in the

classroom by utilizing curricula from *The Set Me Free Project* and *The Foundation United* that cover all grade levels. Topics include identifying trustworthy people, sexting, sextortion, safety plans, how to stay safe online, what information not to share, and more.

All donations help with continuing education for our youth and community members in Spearfish and surrounding areas. Currently, only 5th grade receives education but with additional funding, they would expand into Junior High & High School.


